If you are contributing a review, please render its title in accordance with those in recent issues. The following example is intended to be all-inclusive; please note punctuation and order:

K. GEORGE, **Gildas's De Excidio Britonum and the Early British Church** (Woodbridge: Boydell Press, 2009). ISBN 978-1-84383-435-9. STG £50.00 (Hb).

Word limit

750 words. In some special cases, where the reviewer feels that a particular publication merits a more thorough discussion, the editors will consider a larger word count.

Fonts

Times New Roman. Greek and Latin should only be included where absolutely necessary. If using Greek use a Unicode font.

References

Please use in-text references rather than footnotes/ endnotes (*Classics Ireland*, 2014).

General

In general we would like you to remember that the primary readership of *Classics Ireland* is non-academic. As such, it is also useful to provide a general, albeit brief, overview of the work under review.
